

## **Learn, Grow, Be Resilient! Cross-border Education Project for Young People from RO and MD**

Project duration: 14 months

The specific objective of the project is to enhance equal access to inclusive and quality education services over a 14-month period through collaborative educational interventions. This endeavor seeks to cultivate new competences innovatively, capitalizing on emerging opportunities for both countries, Republic of Moldova (with impact in Floresti, Drochia, and Soroca) and Romania (with impact in Iasi, Vaslui, and Botosani). This is achieved through joint solutions and cooperation between stakeholders in the education domain from both Republic of Moldova and Romania.

This specific objective will directly contribute to the program's result indicator, which involves three organizations collaborating across borders, both during and after project completion, to develop joint educational tools and implement joint actions in the field of education, such as workshops and exchange programs.

Communication Objective 1 aims to raise awareness among education stakeholders about the significance of inclusive and quality education services in preparing specialists for the increasingly competitive European future labor markets. Through achieving this objective, the project endeavors to elevate knowledge levels among teachers, influence stakeholder behavior, and reshape students' beliefs.

The target audience for Communication Objective 1 includes 70 youngsters from Romania, 80 youngsters from Moldova, and 180 individuals participating in dissemination events, including school staff, teachers, and stakeholders from both countries.

Communication Objective 2 focuses on ensuring proper visibility for the EU's contribution to project financing, thereby enhancing public awareness of EU actions in the Life Science Domain and presenting a cohesive picture of EU support. The target audience for this objective comprises 330 individuals, including pupils, their parents, teachers, and stakeholders.

The project's duration is set at 14 months, with project partners including the Love and Trust Association, Community Association Fate, and Constantin Stere Theoretical High School.
